Choice CleanGear reserves the right to perform a Soil Transfer Test (STT) on any item(s) cleaned by the customer to determine if the item meets Choice CleanGear's cleaning and safety standards before being handled by a our employees.  
Items that fail the STT will be cleaned and billed at the current Level 1 cleaning fee.  
If unprotected dirty items are dropped off or shipped in the same box/bag as clean items, then ALL items in the bundle or box will be cleaned.  
Choice CleanGear will not perform Advanced Inspection services or prepare Estimates on items that are not clean.  
Choice CleanGear employees are authorized to re-submit customer cleaned items to be cleaned if it is determined that the item is not safe for handling.*
